CGEIT Certification Prerequisites

As an ISACA Accredited Training Partner, Eminere Group proudly offers expert-led Certified in the Governance of Enterprise IT (CGEIT) training programs. Here are the official prerequisites for the CGEIT exam, based on ISACA's eligibility criteria:

To earn the CGEIT certification, you must meet the following experience requirements:

1. Work Experience Requirement

- At least five (5) years of work experience in enterprise IT (GEIT) governance is required.
- This experience must be gained within the 10 years preceding the application for certification or within five years from passing the CGEIT exam.

2. Qualifying Experience Areas

- At least one year of experience must be related to CGEIT Domain 1: Governance of Enterprise IT.
- The remaining four years must be distributed across at least two of the other CGEIT domains, which include:
 - Domain 2: IT Resources
 - Domain 3: Benefits Realization
 - Domain 4: Risk Optimization

3. Substitutions

- No experience waivers or substitutions (such as degrees or other certifications) are permitted for CGEIT. All five years must be professional work experience in relevant domains.

CGEIT Exam – Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

What is CGEIT?

CGEIT stands for Certified in the Governance of Enterprise IT. An ISACA certification validates a professional's knowledge and experience in IT governance, risk management, and value delivery at the enterprise level.

Who should pursue CGEIT certification?

CGEIT is ideal for professionals in roles such as:

- CIOs, CISOs, CTOs
- IT governance professionals
- Risk and compliance managers
- IT auditors
- Enterprise architects

It is designed for individuals managing, advising, or assuring enterprise IT governance frameworks

What are the prerequisites for the CGEIT exam?

You must have at least five (5) years of work experience in IT governance. One year must be in Domain 1 (Governance of Enterprise IT), with the other four years across at least two of the remaining three domains. No waivers or substitutions are permitted.

Can I take the CGEIT exam before I meet the experience requirement?

Yes. You can take the exam first and then submit the required work experience within five years of passing the exam to become certified.

What is the format and length of the CGEIT exam?

The exam consists of 150 multiple-choice questions and must be completed within 4 hours. It is offered both online with remote proctoring and in person.

What topics or domains does the exam cover?

The exam is divided into four domains:

- **Domain 1:** Governance of Enterprise IT (40%)
- **Domain 2:** IT Resources (15%)
- **Domain 3:** Benefits Realization (26%)
- **Domain 4:** Risk Optimization (19%)

How should I prepare for the CGEIT exam?

How long is the CGEIT certification valid?

To maintain certification, CGEIT holders must earn 20 CPE hours annually and 120 CPE hours over three years.
